Dear Friends,

Did you know? I frequently hear from our members that they were grateful, and somewhat surprised, to receive daily visits from First Christian Church during a hospitalization. Our clergy staff—Rev. Kroll and myself—make hospital calls at Meritus Health several days each week. Our lay hospital chaplains, Diann Smith, Cal Scholl, and Mark Goller currently cover the other days of the week. Jerry Norris has also served in this role in the recent past. These good and faithful servants have undertaken a course of training and volunteer their time to be the presence of the church to those who have been hospitalized. I wanted to use this space to make sure you know who they are and why they do what they do. If you see one of these fine people appear in your hospital door, they are the presence of the church—the Body of Christ—there to offer prayers and to remind you that your congregation is with you even when you can't be with us. If you see them in worship on a Sunday morning, please take a moment to thank them for the significant ministry they offer.



Diann Smith currently visits at Meritus Health on Saturday and Sunday. She says, "I have been blessed to be a part of the church family at First Christian Church my entire life, and have loved and been nurtured by them through glad times and sad times. I have been visiting members and families of First Christian Church ever since 2001, and am privileged to get to know our members and their families, pray for them and with them as I witness them struggle to endure the challenges they have been given, and walk with them on their journeys according to God's plan."

Cal Scholl (pictured here with his wife, Carolyn) visits patients at Meritus Health, Chambersburg Hospital, and Waynesboro Hospital. He has served as volunteer chaplain since 2005, having logged over 7,000 hours of volunteering in that time. Cal visits our members who have been hospitalized on Mondays. He says, "I frequently visit with and have prayer with patients before they go in for surgery. If I can bring comfort to those who are hurting from physical or emotional pain then I feel I have achieved my goal. I frequently get more out of what a patient says to me than I feel I give to the patient. They strengthen my faith."



Mark Goller (pictured here with his wife, Sue) is the newest member of our lay hospital chaplain team. Mark says, "During my three Elder term's at FCC from 2003 to present I learned to cherish my encounters with 'friends at home' church members. My spiritual motivation also grew from the many other worship service duties I performed as deacon and elder for the past 20 years within the congregation. My faith in God has motivated my desire to serve and help others. When I retired from my employment career I felt the desire to increase my

learning experience in pastoral care ministry. This January I enrolled in Clinical Pastoral Education as a Chaplain Intern (volunteer) thru the Meritus Medical Center. I'm at the hospital Tuesday and Thursday and 'on-call' weekends learning and enhancing my pastoral and clinical care skill set. I enjoy bringing listening, solace, and comfort to folks in times of need and trust that God will continue to support my spiritual talents to carry this out."

Last, but certainly not least, I want to recognize Jerry Norris who, although not currently active in making hospital visits, has served our congregation in this capacity for a number of years. Jerry was especially faithful and diligent in making sure that our congregants received hospital visits spanning the illness and death of my predecessor, Rev. Steven Johns-Boehme, and the arrival of Rev. Kroll as Minister of Pastoral Care in 2015 and myself in 2016. I know that many of you have enjoyed Jerry's visits over the years and he continues to be a blessing to our church family.



I offer thanksgiving for Diann, Cal, Mark, and Jerry on behalf of the whole church and I am personally grateful to have them as colleagues in the ministry. Next time you run into one of these fine people in church or in the community, take a moment to thank them. If you have seen them in the hospital, perhaps you can share a word about what it meant to you for the church to offer the ministry of presence, in addition to our prayers. Together, we are the Body of Christ. When every member of the body is using their God-given gifts for betterment of all, the whole body is stronger, healthier, and more whole.

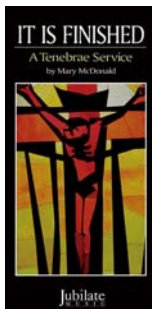

The word "Tenebrae" comes from the Latin meaning "darkness." The Tenebrae is an ancient Christian Holy Week service that makes use of gradually diminishing light through the extinguishing of candles to symbolize the events of that week from the triumphant Palm Sunday entry through Jesus' burial.

This increasing darkness symbolizes the approaching darkness of Jesus' death and of hopelessness in the world without God. The service concludes in darkness, sometimes with a final candle, the Christ Candle, carried out of the Sanctuary, symbolizing the death of Jesus. The worshipers then leave in silence to ponder the impact of Christ's death and await the coming Resurrection.

At First Christian Church we will gather for a worship experience on Thursday, April 18th at 7:00 PM in the Sanctuary as the Chancel Choir presents "It is Finished" by Mary McDonald. This presentation will include a live orchestra, PowerPoint projections, and holy communion. We will move from light into darkness as we mourn Christ's suffering and the suffering of the world. This time for repentance, turning toward God and reflecting on our lives is the final step on our Holy Week preparation for Easter's new life.

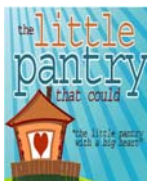
